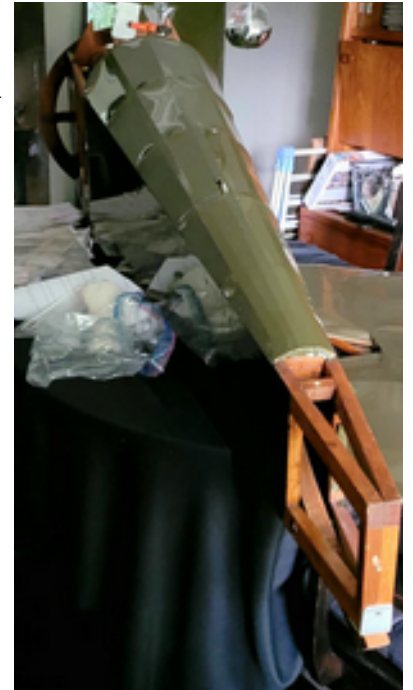
**Sopwith Camel** - Here the lower port wing is getting skinned courtesy of **John** and **Paul**. The lower wings have a 5 deg dihedral which is set by the two struts when slid into the fuselage pocket.



When the plane is assembled cables strung from the inside of the upper wings provide some support. Or is it a submarine?



Here is the covered fuselage sat on **Doug's** dining room table pending final assembly.



**Fokker DR1 Fuselage:** Another day another strip. Each outside runner is made up of 9 1/4" square strips. On this lower aft section they curve both in and up. Cross pieces are temporarily nailed to the jig walls. Clamps and clamps and plastic pegs...
